## Best fit

Service businesses with one repeated operational handoff that leaks owner time, follow-up, delivery quality, or cash collection.

### Useful volume

10+ weekly handoffs helps patterns show up.

### Safe inputs

Redacted examples, templates, notes, screenshots, and rough numbers.

### Payback Clarity Guarantee

If the report does not identify at least three practical improvements with a clear first payback path, it will be revised once or refunded.

## How to start

1. Run the browser AI intake.
2. Confirm one workflow, safe materials, and review boundaries. 3. Pay only after scope is clear.

## Prep time

Usually 30-45 minutes: one workflow, rough volume, current tools, examples, and approval rules. No passwords or private customer lists.

## Timing

The 72-hour clock starts after workflow, scope, payment, and safe materials are confirmed - not after reading the page or using intake.

## Included

One buyer-ready report for one workflow, AI readiness scoring, ranked payback opportunities, oversight rules, starter prompts/SOPs, first pilot ticket, and 30-day operating plan.

## Not included

Implementation, managed automation, live CRM changes, unreviewed customer messages, password/API access, guaranteed ROI, revenue promises, or ongoing support unless separately scoped.
